Assuming the requirements are met and admittance is granted, students can take up to 3 graduate MCJ courses between the fall and spring semesters of the senior year; students can also take MCJ courses in the summer following the senior year prior to the start of the fifth year. Juniors are required to complete a written application, which requires at least two letters of recommendation.

^{**} In addition to the 9 credits taken during the senior year, the MCJ curriculum can be completed online with an additional 21 credits for a total of 30 credits.
